The following resolution was passed unanimously by the Board of Directors of the Illinois Environmental Council at the Board's September 24, 1978 meeting.

-----The Illinois Environmental Council strongly opposes logging in Illinois State Parks and Conservation Areas for purposes of  
1) forest management; 2) wildlife habitat manipulation; and  
3) revenue.

Logging in State Parks and Conservation areas is a mischievous and conservationally destructive practice.
