One--The Great Lakes Chapter (Illinois) of the Sierra Club authorizes the expenditure of \$1500 as a legal retainer towards legal action against the Illinois Department of Conservation to stop logging in State Parks. (The DOC is taking bids for timber in Pere Marquette State Park near Grafton.)

Two--The Great Lakes Chapter of the Sierra Club appoints Robert Freeman to be Chairman of the Legal Task Force Committee with Ted Woodbury, Great Lakes Chapter Chairman, and George Jackson, Great Lakes Chapter Conservation Chairman, as other members of the Committee.

Three--The Great Lakes Chapter pledges to hold a series of fund raising activities to repay the financial costs of the \$1500 in legal expenses.
